
Diversity Survey Results 2023




4. (b) Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?






8. (b) What type of school did you mainly attend between the ages of 11 and 16?






9.(a) What is the highest level of qualification achieved by either of your parent(s) or guardian(s) by the time you were 18?








12. (b) If yes: i. Did you return to your current employer after the leave?




